

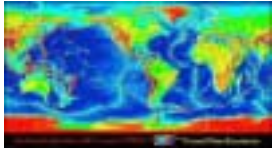

Thailand Warns of Unusual Underwater Tremors

BANGKOK : Thailand warned Saturday of a series of unusual underwater earthquakes in the Andaman Sea, urging caution along its southern coast where the tsunami hit in 2004.

The National Disaster Warning Center said that between March 9-11 it had detected 31 quakes ranging in magnitude from 4.0 to 5.3 near the Andaman Islands, some 500 kilometres (300 miles) east of the southern Thai province of Ranong.

The epicentres have been in an area where underwater volcanoes sometimes erupt along a fault line, it said in a statement.

"It could cause a major eruption of underwater volcanoes, and that could trigger a tsunami that would damage Thailand," the statement said.

The centre's director Plodprasop Suraswadi told Thai television that such a large number of tremors in three days was cause for concern, but said scientists have no way of predicting the chances of another tsunami.

"We must warn people to be cautious, but they should not overreact or panic. It's a abnormal signal that we have detected," he said.

The centre asked the public to listen for further updates, and asked ships off the Thai coast to report any unusual changes in the sea.

Some 5,400 people were killed in Thailand during the December 2004 tsunami which claimed more than 220,000 lives worldwide around the Indian Ocean.

Augustine Volcano

After blowing off more steam and triggering numerous avalanches, scientists say they are noticing something else on Augustine.

Early this morning, geologists saw something new. They began to see a different signal on the seismometers on the island. They say it could have to do with the rate lava's coming out of the ground or the stickiness of the lava. So, they're closely monitoring the volcano.

"We were starting to see very small, repetitive events that we've seen at other volcanoes and actually at Augustine back in 1986, and 1976, during what's called a dome building eruption. So, the signals are very consistent with lava slowly coming out of the ground," said Tina Neal, Volcanologist, USGS.

They say they're still interpreting the signal and trying to figure out what it means. They'll be doing overflights and trying to visit Augustine as soon as weather conditions permit. For now, the code warning remains at orange.

Vesuvius risks 'underestimated'

Researchers are warning that the next eruption of Vesuvius could be much more deadly than the Italian authorities are planning for.

A US-Italian collaboration says deadly blasts have previously caused devastation which swept well beyond modern Naples. Italian plans call for the evacuation of 600,000 people from the city. But the researchers say up to three million people could be at risk according to the new assessment.

Vesuvius is best known for its eruption in AD 79, the eruption that buried the Roman town of Pompeii. Plans for the evacuation of Naples are based on a similar-sized eruption in 1631. But go back about 3,780 years and Vesuvius exploded with even greater force... (Continues)

Strong Earthquake In Admiralty Islands

KUALA LUMPUR - A strong earthquake, measuring 6.1 on the Richter Scale, occurred in the Admiralty Islands at 4.56am Monday, the Malaysian Meteorological Services Department said.

It said the centre of the earthquake was located 3,448km Southeast of Lahad Datu, Sabah, at co-ordinates 2.8 South 148.3 East. Based on its location and magnitude, it said, the earthquake was not expected to generate a tsunami. Admiralty Islands is a cluster of small islands in the southwest Pacific, part of Papua New Guinea.

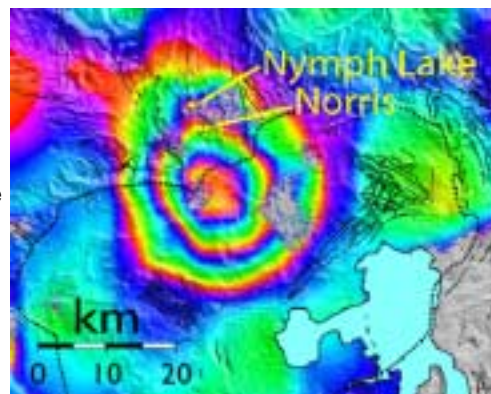

The Changing Face of Yellowstone

The curves, peaks and geysers of Yellowstone National Park, immortalized on film by decades of nature photographers and tourists with disposable cameras, may appear to have the permanence of a photo. But subterranean shifts in basaltic magma are changing the face of Yellowstone, meaning eventually we may have to toss out some of those Ansel Adams calendars.

Scientists at the US Geological Survey, reporting in the March 2nd issue of Nature, used satellites from the European Space Agency to track a bubble of magma on the northern rim of Yellowstone's caldera, or crater. The bubble has risen as the rest of the caldera has sunk over the past six years. This activity spiked temperatures in the park's geyser basins and led the Steamboat Geyser to spurt with uncharacteristic frequency, five times between 2000 and 2003 after a nine-year hiatus.



"It was an area about 40 km across that was uplifting," said co-author Charles Wicks of the USGS, describing the growing bulge at the crater's edge. "It uplifted about 120 mm over about a six year period."

Wicks and his colleagues hypothesize that basaltic magma spread out beneath the caldera, bubbling up toward potential outlets around the rim and causing the dip in the center of the caldera. But a stream of magma, about 15 to 19 km under the earth's surface, has accumulated at a clogged valve on the caldera's rim, forming the bulge. The process is somewhat similar to the way a clogged pore can cause a pimple.

"We think that this valve controls how fast the magma can go out," Wicks said. "It was restricted, and the magma inflated."

Aside from the bulge, perturbations underground have also led to increased geyser activity in the Park, according to Wicks.

"It's like if you have a slab of clay and you bend it, you see the bottom part of it compress and the top part get some little cracks and open up," he said. "So, we think that's what's happening here."

Wicks said a 10 km thick crust is bending due to this magma dip, which open up pathways in the shallow geothermal system causing geysers to burst and water temperature to rise.

While this accumulation of magma in one spot could, under certain circumstances, lead to a volcanic eruption, Wicks is optimistic that there will be no volcanic eruption.

"We think in this case the magma doesn't have a good path to the surface, so at some point, as it becomes more dense, it cools a little bit and goes back down," he said. "It would take a very strong pulse of magma to actually break through the overlying crust and cause an eruption."

Whether or not Yellowstone is about to be home to a hot pit of lava, its topography will never look the same again.

I think they are underestimating Yellowstone much like they have underestimated just about everything geo/weather-wise in the past 30 years. New Technique Provides First Full View of Far Side of Sun

The hidden face of the sun is fully visible for the first time, thanks to a new technique developed at Stanford University.

Only half of the sun-the near side-is directly observable. The far side always faces away from Earth and is therefore out of view. But the new technology allows anyone with a computer to download images of the entire solar surface-an important advance with practical applications, say researchers, because potentially damaging solar storms that form on the far side now can be detected days, or even weeks, before they wreak havoc on Earth.



“Sunspots, solar flares and other active regions on the surface of the sun emit radiation that can interfere with orbiting satellites, telecommunications and power transmission,” says Philip Scherrer, research professor in the Department of Physics. “This new method allows more reliable warning of magnetic storms brewing on the far side that could rotate with the sun and threaten the Earth.”

It takes about 27 days for the sun to rotate on its axis, so an active region that forms on the far side can remain hidden for up to 13 days and surprise Earth-bound observers when it finally rotates into view. That’s what happened in October 2003, when active regions from the back side suddenly appeared on the eastern edge of the sun, spewing X-rays, ultraviolet radiation and high-energy particles into space. “We were not able to make a public prediction about the intensity of that activity, because at the time we could only image about a quarter to a third of the far side,” Scherrer says. “The new method allows us to see the entire far side, including the poles.”

Scherrer and his Stanford colleagues study the sun using data from the Solar and Heliospheric Observatory (SOHO), a research satellite launched in 1995 by NASA and the European Space Agency. On board SOHO is the Michelson Doppler Imager (MDI), an electronic instrument that creates images of the sun’s interior by measuring the velocity of sound waves produced by hot, bubbling gases that well up to the surface-a technique called acoustic helioseismology.

“Helioseismology works on the same principle as medical ultrasound, which can create an image of a fetus inside a pregnant woman,” Scherrer explains. “In this case, we’re looking through a star with sound waves.”

Positioned about 1 million miles above Earth, the SOHO satellite always faces the visible side of the sun. In 2000 and 2001, scientists Charles Lindsey and Doug Braun-now at NorthWest Research Associates Inc.-developed two techniques that resulted in the first pictures of the sun’s back side. However, both techniques had limitations. One method only produced images near the center of the far side, while the other was restricted to views at the edges. To get a complete image, researchers would have to combine both methods, but that proved to be a major technical challenge.

The problem was finally overcome last summer when a new computer algorithm was developed by the Stanford SOHO/MDI team in collaboration with Kenneth Oslund, an undergraduate at the California Institute of Technology. Their work resulted in the MDI Farside Graphics Viewer, which displays the first full images of the far side of the sun. The viewer is available [online](#).

“This new method is a vast improvement,” Scherrer says. “It should be especially important during the next solar maximum, which should begin in 2011, when solar activity will be at its peak.”

He points out that during the last “solar max,” which lasted from 2000 to 2003, solar storms temporarily knocked out power in the northern parts of Sweden and Canada and destroyed a satellite that was used to verify credit card payments at numerous gas stations in the United States. Air transportation also can be disrupted when solar radiation interferes with the operation of Global Positioning System satellites, or when aircraft that take shortcuts over the North Pole have to take longer routes to prevent passengers and crew from being exposed to intense X-ray radiation.... Strong Earthquake Rocks Eastern Indonesia

JAKARTA, Indonesia A powerful undersea earthquake rocked Indonesia's eastern coast on Tuesday, causing panic but no serious damage, officials said. There were unconfirmed reports it triggered a small, nondestructive tsunami, police said.

The 6.8-quake struck 93 kilometers (58 miles) west of Ambon, the capital of Maluku province, the U.S. geological survey said on its Web site.

Residents in Ambon and other towns close to the epicenter some 40 kilometers (25 miles) under the ocean fled homes and offices when the temblor hit, witnesses said.

"I was surprised, and everyone ran onto the streets because we really felt the shaking," said Daniel Leonard from Ambon, around 3,000 kilometers (1,900 miles) north east of the capital, Jakarta.

The region was then hit by several aftershocks, witnesses said.

A police officer on the nearby island of Buru said locals living on the coast reportedly saw the sea withdraw by several feet (meters) and then rush in land by around 10 centimeters (4 inches) further than before.

"But I cannot not confirm this because I myself did not see it," said Sgt. Usro, in Namlea, the main town on Buru island.

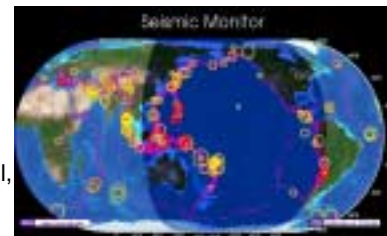
Usro, who only gave a single name, said there were no reports of damage, either from the quake or the apparent tsunami.

The Pacific Tsunami Warning Center said there "there was a very small possibility" that the quake would generate a small tsunami that could affect coasts no more than 100 kilometers (62 miles) from the epicenter.

Indonesia, the world's largest archipelago, sits atop a volcanically active region in the Pacific known as the Ring of Fire and is rocked daily by earthquakes of varying magnitudes.

In December 2004, a 9.1-magnitude earthquake off the coast of Sumatra Island triggered the Asian tsunami, killing more than 131,000 people in Aceh and leaving tens of thousands more missing.

Stardust: Answering Cosmic Questions

Stardust samples of comet particles might seem like a strange place to find a big component of the green sand found on some Hawaiian beaches, but there it was. The spacecraft, which flew within 150 miles of the comet Wild 2 in January 2004, brought back samples that may provide new insights into the composition of comets and how they vary from one another, scientists said Monday.

"Remarkably enough, we have found fire and ice," said Donald Brownlee, Stardust principal investigator and professor of astronomy at the University of Washington in Seattle. The returned samples show high-temperature materials from the coldest part of our solar system.

Brownlee and fellow scientists spoke at NASA's Johnson Space Center to reporters at JSC and at other NASA Centers.

Comets, they said, may not be as simple as the clouds of ice, dust and gases they were thought to comprise. They may be diverse with complex and varied histories. Wild 2 seems to be an example of that complexity... (cont.)

100 twisters across 5 states

SEDALIA, Missouri (AP) -- The frozen chicken that Joy Rank had been thawing for dinner was still soaking the next morning in a sink full of water -- a meal abandoned when Rank watched a scene of terror unfold outside her kitchen window.

A tornado tore through the mobile home park she co-owns Sunday night, flipping over one of six occupied homes and killing a 39-year-old woman inside.

"There's not a lot of damage to the homes people live in," Rank said Monday, crying while sipping coffee in the dim candlelight of her kitchen. But "it really bothered me that a girl had to lose her life."

Early reports show more than 100 twisters touched down in a weekend wave that stretched across five states, from Oklahoma to Illinois. Nine of the ten dead were in Missouri. ([Watch what makes jaws drop and heads shake -- 6:09](#))

"It's just amazing how devastating it is," said Mayor Tim Davlin of the Illinois capital of Springfield. "It looks like the pictures we saw a couple months ago after Katrina." (Continues)

Thirty injured in Larry's wake

FAR north Queensland is reeling tonight after a category-five cyclone likened to an atomic bomb ripped through the area, damaging thousands of buildings and devastating crops.

Innisfail, south of Cairns, bore the brunt of Cyclone Larry's 290km/h winds as it tore roofs from buildings and flattened or uprooted trees.

Amazingly, no one was killed in the storm, but at least 30 people were injured.

A Counter Disaster and Rescue Service (CDRS) spokeswoman today said authorities had received reports that at least 30 people had received minor injuries, including cuts and abrasions.

The Innisfail hospital sustained severe damage but no staff or patients were injured, she said.

Hundreds of millions of dollars damage was inflicted as the category-five storm - the strongest possible - also destroyed most of Australia's banana crop and flattened sugar cane fields.

Authorities had evacuated more than 1000 residents in the lead-up to the storm. Acting Queensland Ambulance Service commissioner Neil Kirby said he was "absolutely astounded" at the low injury rate.

But around half the buildings in the town of Innisfail were damaged, emergency services estimated, while smaller towns in the region also took the brunt of the cyclone.

6.4 M Earthquake and 5 Meter Tidal Wave Hits Indonesia

Mar 17, 2006

OCHA Situation Report No. 1
Indonesia – Earthquake - Update
Namlea District - Maluku Province



I. SITUATION

1. The recent 6.4 M earthquake and 5 metre tidal wave that occurred in the aftermath of the earthquake has caused two fatalities, and seriously injured one person. One person has been reported as missing.
2. According to the local authorities, the quake also caused heavy damage to houses in Pela Village (116), Batu Jungku Village (54), Waimorot Village (30), Wailawa Village (25), and Waimoly Village (16). It has not been specified whether these damaged houses are easily repaired or still habitable. These villages are located in Bata Bual Sub-District.
3. Local media reported (16 March) that some 1,200 persons from Batu Jungku and Pelang Village of Bata Bual Sub-District fled from their homes to higher/mountainous areas. Pelang villagers fled to a mountainous area that is 5 kilometres from Pelang Village. Meanwhile, Batu Jungku villagers fled to higher ground 2 kilometres from Batu Jungku Village. This information has not been confirmed by local authorities.
4. Bata Bual Sub-District is a coastal area, located approximately 50 kilometres southeast of Namlea City, capital city of Buru District. It can be reached by land (4 hours drive) or by sea (45 minutes) from Namlea.

II. NATIONAL RESPONSES

5. The Governor of Maluku Province visited the affected areas on the day after the earthquake struck (15 Mar). The local government has provided basic emergency assistance (e.g., food, medical supplies, blankets, etc.) to the affected people.
6. The Central Government (BAKORNAS PB, Ministry of Social Affairs, and Ministry of Health) is monitoring the situation through its contacts with local authorities.
7. The Indonesian Red Cross (PMI) is sending staff to the southern part of Buru Island, as well as to Ambalau Island to assess the impact of the earthquake.

III. INTERNATIONAL RESPONSE

8. The UN RC/HC Office in Jakarta will continue to be in direct contact with the appropriate government and non-governmental institutions, as well as with the Indonesian Red Cross, and will continue to monitor the situation.
9. UNICEF, OXFAM GB, MSF- BELGIUM and CARDI are also continuing to monitor the situation.
10. CRS will send its staff to undertake an assessment in the affected areas during the next week.
11. Unless the situation deteriorates further, OCHA will not issue further situation reports regarding this emergency.

Bulusan volcano remains unsettled, emits strong steam: More explosions expected

BULUSAN volcano emits a continuous jet of steam after belching ash high into the sky overnight, but scientists say there is no imminent danger of a violent eruption.

Mount Bulusan spewed 1.5-kilometer-high ash columns into the sky at 10:58 p.m. Tuesday, the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs) said. No one was reported hurt.

Jaime Sincioco, in charge of monitoring volcanoes at the government institute, said the activity was followed by three more separate phreatic explosions -- ash puffs caused by magma coming into contact with water.

"There is strong steaming activity," Sincioco said. More eruptions were expected "in view of the volcano's recent reactivation" following volcanic quakes on Saturday, Phivolcs said in its bulletin on Wednesday.

The 5,115-foot volcano, located in Sorsogon province, 390 kilometers southeast of Manila, has been rumbling since Saturday. The steam-driven explosion lasted for 20 minutes and was accompanied by four earthquakes, Phivolcs said.

"The explosion indicates there is abnormality," Phivolcs director Renato Solidum told GMA Network's "Saksi" newscast, adding very light ash falls were reported in several villages north, west and southwest of the volcano in the towns of Irosin and Juban.

"This recent ash explosion is more or less typical of Bulusan's activity during its restive period," Phivolcs said.

The explosion was accompanied by one explosion-type earthquake, and followed by three more explosion-type earthquakes recorded at 11:30 p.m., 11:32 p.m. and 11:37 p.m., Phivolcs said.

Very light ash falls poured down on the villages of Cogon, Tinampo, Gulang-Gulang and Bolos in Irosin; Puting Sapa and Bura-Buran in Juban; and some other villages in Sorsogon province.

Sincioco said the last time the volcano acted up in the same way was between November 1994 and January 1995.

He said volcanic ash was being collected to determine how deep inside the mountain it originated. Ground deformation also will be measured to discover whether fresh magma is rising.

The institute raised the five-stage alert level on the volcano from 0 to 1 to indicate "abnormality or unrest" after an increase in volcanic quakes, said Sincioco.

The agency warned people to stay away from areas within four kilometers from the crater.

Phivolcs has dispatched its Quick Response Team to augment the monitoring networks around the volcano. It has also raised alert level 1 in Bulusan, designating the four-kilometer radius around the volcano as permanent danger zone (PDZ).

The PDZ is an area that should be off-limits to the public because this will be affected by sudden steam explosions. Mount Bulusan has had 15 recorded eruptions. It last erupted in January 2005.

The Philippines is in the Pacific "Ring of Fire," where volcanic activity and earthquakes are common. In June 1991, Mount Pinatubo in the northern Philippines exploded in one of the world's biggest volcanic eruptions in the 20th century.

Another thing that defined my unconventional toddlersque style were my vivid dreams. Many were waking dreams, and often nightmares. I would find myself traveling back and forth through time to different cultures. The most recurring dream was set in ancient Greece. In the dream, I was a young girl of about six or seven. I was walking on a hill top and stumbled upon a terrible scene. Three men had captured another man and had him tied to the stone table on top of the hill. I hid in the brush. When the men were convinced their victim was secure, they left. I don't remember the reason but they had said they would be coming back shortly. I ran to the table and crawled underneath it to untie the man's bonds, but before I could finish, the men came back and caught me. I always woke up terrified. The truly interesting thing about this dream is that in the dream, I spoke the language of the region and time. I sometimes spoke out loud in my sleep, various languages from various places I had visited in the night. My entire family realized I was quite different.

I also dreamt of weather events. Things I had never witnessed. I enjoyed and respected the tornadoes as they were very communicative. They did not speak in words, just feeling I guess you might call it. A telepathic non-verbal language. If they were on path to a city I could call to them and they would become non-local and be next to me and in the other place simultaneously. I would ask them kindly to go around the city and not hurt anybody. I was very aware of their power even though at age two and three I had not ever witnessed one in real life. I knew also that they were neutral in nature. This meant I had to negotiate in a respectful and thoughtful manner that suited their paradoxical stance. Of course upon waking, I had no way of knowing if a tornado had barely missed a city that day, but I am betting now from experience, it probably had.

I had never read about "psychics" at that age... Dr. Suess never mentioned them, much less telekinesis, yet I instinctively knew that the physical world was pliable. I would choose objects and try to move them with my mind. I was tireless. I was the kind of kid who could sit silently for hours lost in whatever had my attention. Although it is strange behaviour, I think my parents appreciated it. I would also try to fly. Moving through limbed motions seemed foreign to me. I kept trying to fly until about age 4. I came to the conclusion that, and I remember this exactly, "The reason I can't fly is because I have never witnessed another person flying. I simply don't have enough faith to break through. Someday, I will." At the time of course I did not realize that other children did not think the way I did. I have to admit that I am myself a bit amazed I should have such a thought at that age. I also did not succeed in making objects move... at that time. I chalked it up to the same reasoning.

The next story I will tell is a bit disturbing, and a bit lovely. It would not surprise you that I say I have no rational explanation for this one either. I will try however, toward the end.

When I was two, my family rented a camper and we traveled across the country from Michigan to Seattle, Washington. I had been having nightmares before we left, for about a year. Recurring, waking, nightmares. I was concerned they would happen while we traveled. I call them "waking nightmares" even though they don't fit the normal parameters for this phenomenon. They would happen *before* I fell asleep.

Every night, two small beings would appear in the window of my bedroom and talk to me. I called them "the puppets". They looked like puppets, but no puppets I had ever seen. One looked like a bald man; the other looked like a snake. They terrified me. I do not remember anything they said, except for one night when they threatened to kill my father. I ran out to my mother sobbing that "the puppets would kill dad if he didn't get home before a certain time." She really did not know how to console me but let me wait up in the living room with her until my dad got home.

Back to the trip. My concerns about "the puppets" were uneventful until we reached Montana. (I remember the campground but did not know what state we had been in. I asked my father where we were when this happened two years before he died.) It was twilight; we were all in the car and not the camper. My father had found a campground and turned down the road toward it. There were two burns of some sort on the side of the road and it did not look like we could get the car through them. My dad thought he could, so he proceeded. We got stuck. My mother and I stayed in the car while my father and brother attempted to "unstick" us.

It was dark now, and my concerns about "the puppets" grew. I voiced the concern to my mother and she told me there was no need. I sat in her lap and waited for my dad and brother to free the car. Suddenly, in the window, there they were. The puppets. I don't recall what happened after that. I remember becoming hysterical. The next thing I knew, my father had freed the car and we were pulling into a camping spot. Sounds like a typical childhood dilemma right?

The next morning, I awoke very early. It was still dark. I did not want to wake anyone up, so I grabbed a toy my parents had bought for me the previous day at a gas station. It was a Santa Clause that rocked down a metal pole into a chimney. I played with the toy silently until I felt a strange compulsion to look out the window of the camper. I peered out into twilight. The campground was deserted except for us. There was a ridge of trees in the distance and my attention focused on those trees. I saw what at first was a white blob coming out from under the trees. As it came closer, I thought it was a man. An all white man. It was headed straight for the camper. Closer still, I thought that "it looks like it is a man made of white rocks". There was no fear in me what-so-ever. I remained silent.

This being stopped at the window of the camper. It stared in at me, and I will tell you, I remember everything about him... except for his eyes. I can't tell you what his eyes looked like, oddly enough. He had to have been very tall to look in at me through that camper window from the ground. Being older, I can now say he looked like he was half man and half reptile. He was pure white with an engorged pre-frontal cortex. As a child, I mistook the large, plated reptile skin for "rocks".

He began to speak to me telepathically. His mouth never moved. He said, "I am your guardian. I am here to protect you. I love you." I felt an overwhelming sense of love and well being. He turned and walked back into the woods. I was transfixed for a time but then I ran to my parents and woke them up and began telling them how this "monster made of white rocks" had come to visit me and what he had said. I looked for him the rest of the trip, but never saw him again. I also knew that I would never again see "the puppets" because he would keep them away.

A few years ago, my father brought a book for me to read. He wanted my opinion as my Uncle John had given him the book. It was a book by David Icke (Yes, I can hear the sniggers now LOL). I gave him my opinion. The book is very well researched but the conclusions are off. It did spawn me to purchase another Icke book. In the book, was a drawing... of exactly what I saw.

A white reptile man. Icke's take on them was basically that they were the hierarchy of an evil reptile race of aliens. "Evil" has not ever entered my mind when I think about the encounter. That being was capable of more pure love than any human I have ever met.

Don't get me wrong, I am not saying it was indeed a reptile alien (although that is certainly the impression I still carry). In all fairness, let me share something with you. As for "the puppets". How many remember the show "Kukla, Fran, and Ollie"? The puppets... were... Kukla and Ollie. *However*, at the time I was having these waking nightmares, I had never seen nor heard of the show. I remember vividly what happened after I *did* see the show for the first time. I flipped out. I turned off the TV. Even Fran scared me and I had never seen her in the nightmares. The show first aired October 13, 1947, long before I was born. Incidentally, my father died on October 13 and he died on an extended vacation in the mountains where no ambulance could get to him in time (2000 though... but still, remember the puppets threatening to kill my father? I just now found that out, by the by, and I am currently very creeped out). The show ended in 1957, still several years before I was born. Reruns ran from 57' to the '80's. I was born in '64. I still swear to you I had never seen that show until *after* these events, but I guess it's a plausible alternative to them being real.

Also, in 1967, "The Fantastic Four" entered the cartoon scene. The creature called "The Thing" other than being orange, looks very much like my white reptile creature. However, the show did not first air until September 9th, 1967. I would have been three then, not two. It aired *after* I saw the creature.

That's my best stab to try and discredit my experiences through subconscious waking nightmares. The dates don't jibe... except in my father's death. I can't say if I believe aliens are real. I can say that from experiences later in life and through reading other's experiences, that the general consensus among believers is that certain aliens can change shape. Would perhaps they take a form that a child's mind could understand? Such as a puppet? Why did I perceive the white reptile/man as... a white reptile man? Was it all my subconscious mind? I don't know. There was one more incident, but this was in 1997. That is a few chapters away.

The Paranormal (Part 1) Channeling & Mediumship

Although I thought the book to be very flavored in identity, the knowledge displayed of future events was extremely accurate. I couldn't even get a "she's lying" vibe from the books. I still have no doubt this really happened to her, albeit as I said, flavored through identities she could accept through her subconscious into her conscious mind.

Initially, this article was to be called simply "Channeling", but I have since learned that "Spiritualists" who hold the majority of information on paranormal phenomena, consider channeling and mediumship to be separated events in lieu of the type of information received. "Mediums" receive the deceased and impart personal information, where-as "Channelers" receive information of a nature that is simply informative in spiritual growth endeavors and can usually apply to all. I have experienced both.

In the early 90's, I had my first experience with mediumship. I did not allow the entity to come through, but it felt very much like he was inside of me and it felt very heavy. I didn't like it all. It did spark a memory though, several memories in fact. These were memories of dreams and projections I've had all of my life. In them, I would juxtapose the bodies of other people. Past, present, and future. I never tried to communicate through them, I simply observed them, their situations and thoughts. In all of these cases the people showed no awareness of my presence. It might have been different if I had tried to communicate through them. I on the other hand, was very aware of the entities that attempted to juxtapose me. The most apt description I can give is that it feels very much like what I were to expect if I vomited up a corpse. NONE of these events, whether it was me within someone else, or them within me, did I ask for. They all just happened randomly. The only entities I seem to get are those that are lost in some way and need answers. "Ghosts" for lack of a better term. "I see dead people" LOL ;o)

I've always believed "ghosts" to be emotional imprints in the magnetic field of the areas they frequented in life. I now have to renege on that belief. Not entirely, but when you have a thinking individual inside of you, it must be concluded that some "ghosts" might actually be trapped spirits. They can also be people who are still alive and looking for answers or merely observing as I did. This is a conclusion my logical mind will not accept, yet it happened, and it happened to me.

They have a message board and the people there are wonderful and very intelligent in most cases. I knew I would get several metaphysical responses, and I did. Also some very good examples from other's experiences. Case in point, this one by Mary Makdissi – aka, starspirit. By the way, I love this woman, she's great. Very insightful ! By Mary Makdissi :

Tuesday, February 28, 2006 - 10:22 am

"My sister has done this a few times. She does'nt call it channeling & she does'nt remember what is said through her.

It is totally weird to see her do it. She takes on the spirit's voice and mannerisms. She says when they enter her body, she moves to the back, 1/2 in and 1/2 out of her body. She lets the spirit say their message and then they leave.

I'll give you a couple of examples...

We were visiting a relative at a nursing home once. As we were leaving an old lady approached walking by us. A woman we definitely did not know. All of a sudden my sister grabbed her arm and said the woman's name. She said to her "bernie wants to speak with you" The woman became all excited and then my sister took on a whole different persona. She was talking deep like a man and her expressions & mannerisms were not her own. You could see the spirit was in her. She told the lady some validation type stuff about their lives together, a bunch of personal stuff, that he loved her etc... My sister had no recall of what was said. But she does remember the spirit man asking to use her. And she described him, so she saw him before he entered.

Another time she took on the persona of a Philippines (sp?) spirit and spoke to a Philippine lady in her native tongue!!! my sister does not speak it, nor any other language!!

My sister does not recall anything that she says to these people. She says she can feel them enter and can stop it, if she wants. As I stated above, She has only done this a few times & they always seem to be spirits who have passed on wanting to talk to loved ones."

Now, anyone from UC and a few others, please note the time of her post. When I asked for her permission to print this, part of her response was this: "I knew there was a reason my sister brought up the channeling she had experienced like the day before I saw that thread. She kept explaining the moving to the back of the body thing." Ah those synchronos, LOL. So by all means you can definitely use that info in the post, for I think you were meant to get it."

Synchronicity? I'd have to say yes. Another sign would be the post time which is 10:22 am. The time of my birth and also a very recurring number in my life, as well as my user ID on Unknown Country.

I must admit, I have come up rather empty handed for science based theory in this arena as "dirkwright" suggested. Mary's post was intriguing because it did not place emphasis on anything that can be pegged as "new age". This is simply an occurrence that happens to her sister and in the same vein of occurrence that happens to me, although I must say her sister handles it far better than I do! Would you like to see an example of one of my experiences? This comes from Robert Ray, better known as Doc Savage and Water God Doc. He is loved by many people and I am one them!

An Eye-Witness Account by Robert Ray

Recently, my friend Krystal Potter asked me to relate something that occurred in her home a few years back. She had asked me if my memories were still clear. I'd have to say that yes, my memories are quite clear about what took place. Such things are very hard to forget.

It was one evening early winter 2001. Krystal and I were sitting in her living room in Mesick, MI., chatting. Krystal started to tense up and remarked that she was very uncomfortable. She said that this had happened before and that this time whomever it was did not know what it was doing.

I asked if she could tell who it was. She said all she could see was a big mouth and bad teeth. She said that whoever it was he had come to talk to me. I began to rack my brain and figure out who I had known that had passed that would fit here. I began to think of my childhood friend, Craig Menzies.

The reason?? Well he looked a lot like Jerry Lewis and our favorite movie of his was Big Mouth. Craig had passed at the end of the 60's from a heroin overdose and was left naked in a street gutter in the rain by his junkie pals. I asked Krystal if it was Craig. She said he became very excited and was nodding.

I got skeptical again and told her to tell him I was sorry about the eye. (When we were 13 he and I got into a fight and I busted up one of his eyes). The reply was, "no problem I'm sorry about the truck!" (When we were 5 he busted my head with a Tonka Truck!) Ok, it's Craig.



Craig said he was in a very dark, damp place and did not know how long he had been there. He said he had really not known or seen anything until he saw me sitting with Krystal. I asked why he was here now and he said he needs my help but he doesn't know why. All he knew was it had been cold wet and dark until he saw me. I did not have a clue as to what I could do to help or why or how I was connected.

I conversed with Craig thru Krystal for a short time than began to see what she was seeing. I saw Craig but he appeared as I last saw him which was back in 1968. Then I noticed a door open up behind Craig with a bright light shining in. I know, it sounds like a cliché but that is what I saw.

Anyway a silhouette appeared in the opening. One that was quite familiar to me. No mistake about this one. A very dear Brother and great Friend passed April 8,2000. He was known simply as CB, a big man with a bigger heart. A man possessed of great spirit. He had come to lead Craig home. That was my connection.

Turns out we had a bit of a problem. Craig did not want to go!! All he had known was this dark place and now he had found me and didn't want to let go. It took at least 20 minutes to convince Craig that he should go with CB. Finally Craig took CB's hand and headed for the door. The last thing I saw was CB's smile and his words "Catch ya later Low Maintenance!!".

From the experience with Doc I remember little. I remember the feeling of heaviness overtake me. I remember a feeling of being grabbed by hands and they did not let go until the being left with Doc's friend. If I've ever experienced a "death grip" that was it. I do remember the initial image of the big mouth and bad teeth. Doc told me afterward that his friend had bad teeth due to all the drug use. There was another part Doc forgot. His friend mentioned the name a girl they had both known and evidently Craig had a crush on her. I remember that part I think because of the sudden change in emotion when he thought of her. I don't remember the name now. Doc would know it. I also remember the first images I got of where this spirit "Craig" was located. I saw night. I saw a grey drainage area with dirty water pouring through the grates. It wasn't pretty.

The example of "channeling" I will give would have taken place around 1984 or 85 I believe. If I could get in touch with this man I would. I know many guys named "Daryl". This incident happened when I was with one of my Daryl friends. In the end I find it great testimony to "The Celestine Prophecy" by James Redfield.

Daryl was having some problems of both a circumstantial and spiritual nature. He asked me to come over and talk with him. His daughter had been kidnapped some months before and he was devastated. He wanted to see her and know that she was ok. He had come to the conclusion that astral projection was the only way he would be able to really see her and know. He asked me to teach him how to astral project. I did.

A couple of weeks later Daryl called me back over to his house and he was wonderfully excited. He told me that he had actually done it and saw his daughter! She was sitting in a yard playing with toys and he was right there with her. He even felt that she might have seen him. He began asking me questions about the nature of the spirit in general. I of course answered as well as I could, but something happened. I began speaking about the nature of the spirit and the universe. I do not remember one word I uttered. What I do remember, is sitting there, aware that I was speaking. I could hear my own words at the time but could not recall them after the experience. My body began to feel very light. This feeling of dwindling mass became more and more pronounced the longer I spoke. My mood was that of a person who is reconciled with everything all at once. Simultaneously euphoric and unemotional. The beauty of ALL enveloped me. I remember being in the back of my mind amused by the feeling of my physical body disappearing. At the time I thought it was just me who was aware of it. When I finished speaking, Daryl was looking at me like he'd seen a ghost. He was markedly moved by whatever it was I had said to him. Beyond that, he said "Do you realize what just happened?" I knew what I had felt, but I didn't want to lead him so I just stared at him. He continued, "You just became transparent! I could see through you into the room over there!"

So, an experience in channeling led to a euphoric non-locality of mass, while a different experience in mediumship led to revulsion. Rather interesting. Perhaps someday I can visit a hypnotist and find out what I said to Daryl. I don't recall it being another entity talking through me. It was more like I had tapped into a part of myself that is removed from space/time. I think of the channelers that are real, most of them need to believe the words come from a "higher source" or it can't happen. I think their "all conscious" knows this and creates everything from aliens to angels. I don't need that as I have always known we are all ONE and that includes every aspect of us in every universe, multiverse, dimension, ad. infin.

But where is the science? I am not looking for proof, merely science based theory. On the board, "Mark" took it into the realm of quantum/particle physics. Albeit vague, the work of one "Greg Braden" was mentioned. I am not familiar with him or his work but the page I read could be applied in part to the channeling phenomenon. <http://team.powerfulintentions.com/forum/topic/2959>

"L.A.B." on the UC message board had this to say: *"Sometimes I wonder if "channeling" is information stored in "cells" of the body or other living things, which people can tap into. We are being sustained by the agreement of these "lower-life-forms" to all progress along the path together. On occasion, I feel they seem to have a vote as to what should be going on in our "shared" lives. Stress will trigger a 'revolt.' Channelers may be tapping into cells/atoms that lived with another person/entity thousands of years ago. (We are what we eat/drink)"*

Very thought provoking! Certainly within the realm of possibility.

Theory from my own cache of "jack of all sciences and master of none" would indicate a hypnotic state that breaches linear time and quantum signatures. I can't help but be led to the study of those with Multiple Personality Disorder (which Patricia Davis mentioned, thank you!) and the symptoms of Schizophrenia. This theory would bring Edgar Cayce into play as he received his visions while in a state of self hypnosis.

In cases of Multiple Personality Disorder, the subject is most often horribly traumatized in early childhood. They unwittingly use self hypnosis to deal with their situations. I must admit, my childhood qualifies, although I was not deemed to be "MPD", I was diagnosed as "heavily compartmentalizing of personality". I have to wonder how many people who channel had traumatic childhoods.

People with MPD attain a standard set of distinct recurring personalities. Most intriguing to me are the physiological changes from personality to personality. One can be allergic to cats while the other is not. One can have an infection but the infection disappears when another personality develops. They have had episodes of eye color change, as well as actual brain wave change. Documented. They also have often displayed very detailed "other lives" including speaking fluently in foreign languages their linear reality has never encountered. Are these fabricated? It would hardly seem so. It's most difficult (impossible) to fabricate brain wave change.

Now if we add a touch of quantum theoretical physics to MPD, we might begin to see a plausible theory. What if people with MPD, and perhaps even Schizophrenia, are not fabricating these personalities/scenarios? What if they are actually malleable enough in psyche to access other quantum signatures, times, and people? What if they are hypnotically connecting to the cumulative and honing in on people that have certain expressions of personality they subconsciously find useful in order to deal with their current reality? Something to ponder.

Applying this theory to channeling and mediumship, one would have to have an even more malleable psyche. One that adheres to the cumulative as a whole instead of a certain set of personalities. They would also need a high rate of abstract thinking capability which can be measured in tests. This is another thing I possess. I don't know the exact score but I rated "superior" on the test which was administered by a very good Psychologist in Michigan. Perhaps by being in Doc's vicinity, I became Doc to the extent I had access to his contacts in the cumulative. Because of my pliable nature, Doc's friend Craig grabbed onto me as soon as my psyche entered Doc's world. I was the missing conduit he had been waiting for. Then, he became me and I became him.

It is my belief, that we are all ONE, in a very real sense. I believe we all share the same spirit, but almost infinite personalities in both time and quantum signature. I believe we are a single organism, but through the chosen illusion of opposition, we have forgotten this. Channeling/mediumship could be a small part of the rebuilding of our recognition of unity. Perhaps we are not as disconnected as we seem.

Survival Tip of the Month

As I am sure you are all aware, natural disasters are increasing exponentially every year. Always best to be prepared.

The most I could glean from our short conversation was a tree had fallen, downed electrical lines... and then I heard a lot of screaming in the background. Needless to say I was a bit disturbed.

The winds were at hurricane force, 78 mph. Both of us lived in the woods and both of us had young children. She was married, I was not, but did have an elderly male renter who was in pretty good physical shape for his age. We had been all toasty and fine... telling stories and getting through. Now it seemed my friend and her family might be in dire trouble and the nearest emergency outfit was nearly 30 miles from her and I am quite sure, far too busy at the moment.

I knew they had no emergency gear. Her husband had a good paying job but was overly indulgent in electronic toys and they never really thought about survival anyway. I had to. I had little money and often no access to utilities at the time. I asked my renter to gather up the heavy stuff and load it into the van (kerosene heaters, oil lamps, battery lamps etc.). I had the girls, 7 and 5, grab the crank/solar radios, extra batteries, blankets, medical supplies and hand them to my renter from the door. I had them get bundled up as well. While they were doing this, I brewed a fresh pot of coffee and thermosed it up, grabbed more coffee and a camping pot I could use on the kerosene heater, grabbed a casserole I had made for dinner (I always made a lot so we could eat on it for a few days), filled jugs of water and grabbed some snacks for the kids. We were all so concerned about my friend and her kids we didn't really think about the dangerous drive ahead. It wouldn't have stopped us if we had. Her kids were my kids best friends.

I wasn't as aware of the severity of the storm until we pulled out into it from the tree canopy. Oh boy. It was a wild ride and more than once entire trees flew in front of the windshield. It was dark and hard to see, water was whipping around everywhere, but I had the girls grab the blankets and run them into the house avoiding downed lines, and to find their friends. I had the guys grab the heavy stuff and my friend and I got the other stuff and we ran it into the house. I caught a brief glimpse of the tree and the car as I neared the house.

We no sooner than entered when my friend and her husband started fighting over the smashed car again, and there was torturous sobbing from their girls. I ignored my friend and found the girls. How they responded to merely the power being out and a tree hitting their car... ended up terrorizing their kids, them, endangering our lives to get to them by making it sound far worse than it actually was, and would have completely debilitated them if a serious crisis had happened! These are not stupid people. Both have IQ's that are well above the norm. Why did they respond this way? Panic. Wrong attitude during crisis. It's an attitude that can get you killed. Teach yourself, teach your kids.

In the past two years they had to close sections of the park as people's shoes were melting on the trails. Seismicity is up and the majority is not being reported. A TV news show said they receive 300+ micro quakes per week and it's normal, not to be concerned, while only a handful appear on the seismic maps on any given month. I have to ask myself, what do I trust more – Bureaucracy or the melted bottoms of my shoes? Tough choice. The fact is, the volcano has erupted approximately every 600,000 years. It is 640,000 years since the last eruption. What are the odds it will happen in your lifetime? Look at your shoes, then get out your calculator.

In the past year, several volcanoes in Alaska have erupted and are erupting in an ongoing manner. Quake activity has increased dramatically. In like form, various geological happenings have also increased at Yellowstone.

It may blow again, but it's not what I would consider a birthing event. To me, that would be something like Hawaii having a massive eruption or a supervolcano. (possibly now due to new information, an underwater eruption of a magnitude that would cause land mass to rise and displacement of ocean water) Having dreams and visions are one thing, interpreting them correctly is another. It could just be another large cascades event. Whatever happens... I will learn from it and become more accurate in my interpretations.
